

## Label and User manual Requirements for FCC Part 15 SDoC:

### Labeling requirements (SDoC):

**The product shall bear the below information in the marking on the device:**

1. Unique identification (trade name and model number)
2. Rating
3. Series number
4. This device complies with part 15 of the FCC Rules. Operation is subject to the following two conditions: (1) This device may not cause harmful interference, and (2) this device must accept any interference received, including interference that may cause undesired operation.
5. FCC LOGO (**Voluntary**)



*Note: When the device is so small or for such use that it is impracticable to label it with the statement (**clause 4 above**) in a font that is four-point or larger, and the device does not have a display that can show electronic labeling, then the information shall be placed in the **user manual and** must also either be placed on the **device packaging** or on a removable label attached to the device. However, Trade Name, and Model Number must still be displayed on the device.*

FCC ID information (**if a FCC certified RF module is inserted in**)

If a certified module is installed inside the host device, then the outside of the host must be labeled with "**Contains FCC ID: \*\*\*\*\***".

To satisfy FCC / IC RF exposure requirements, a separation distance of 20 cm or more should be maintained between the antenna of this device and persons during device operation. To ensure compliance, operations at closer than this distance is not recommended.
